### A Message From the Executive Director

Although the devastation that was left behind in the wake of the Covid years is still with us, Children's Literacy Center has definitely wasted no time in adjusting to the new normal. Tutoring sites have reopened, enrollment is growing, and new ways of modeling our business have emerged. CLC developed an unprecedented relationship with School District 11 that is being looked at statewide as a prototype for many districts. CLC is in semester two of creating quadrants in the district that will eventually service every student in need. This partnership requires a deep understanding with, and cooperation among, the participating community members to help address the losses that students have suffered.

Fiscal year 2021-22 consequently saw an almost doubling in the size of the operating budget to support this groundbreaking endeavor, and positions CLC to be a leader in the state for literacy readiness. It truly is "easier to build strong children than to fix broken men" Frederick Douglass

## 2021 Notable Achievements

- Hired a Director of Education and Regional Director for the Denver Metro Area
- Partnered with Colorado Springs School District 11 to offer a high dosage tutoring program
- Secured funding from a multitude of foundations
- Began a relationship with Gary Community Ventures which will allow for additional financial support
- Began initial conversations with Brown University to help update the Peak Reader Curriculum, review program delivery, and professional development
- Created a paid tutor volunteer program to entice more community members to tutor
- Built relationships with Colorado Department of Education, State Legislatures, Superintendents, and School Administrators
- Partnered with 3 nonprofits to offer tutoring at their facilities
- Concluded a 5-year rural literacy tutoring grant supported by the Coors Foundation and secured additional funding which allows for the program to continue





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
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
