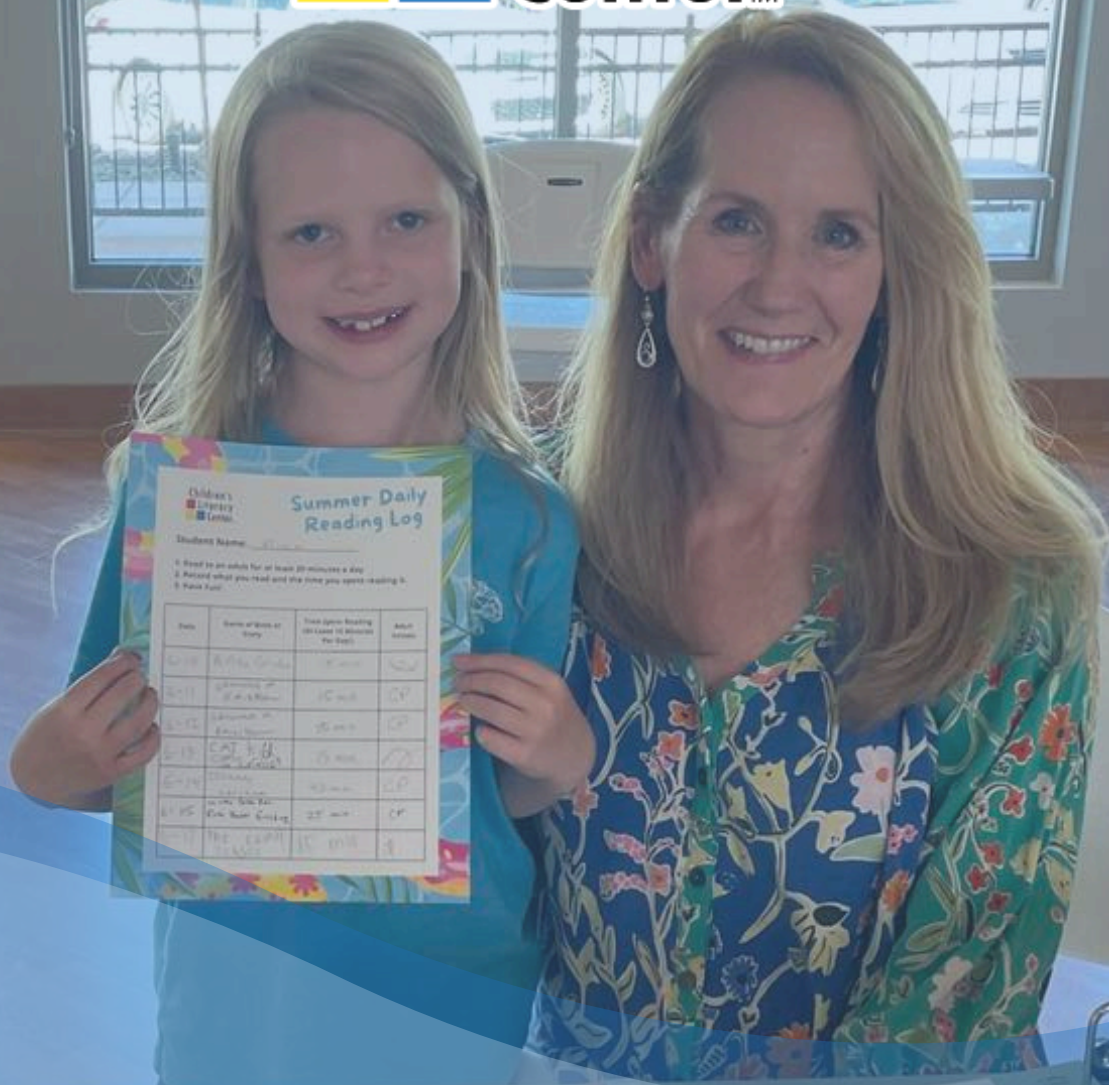

A message from our executive director

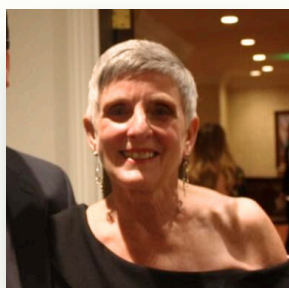
As the Children's Literacy Center reflects on the past fiscal year there are many things to celebrate:

- 580 volunteers served
- Continued the partnership with Colorado Springs District 11 to offer the high intensity tutoring program
- Hosted more than 300 attendees at the 26th Annual Vintner Dinner
- Received funding from 17 foundations
- Continued to build relationships with local school leadership, funders, and supporters
- Updated the Peak Reader Curriculum and Pre-and-Post Assessments
- Partnered with UCCS-College of Public Service and the Lyda Hill Institute to provide an all-day teambuilding activity
- Reestablished relationship with the YMCA of the Pikes Peak Region to open a tutoring site in Fountain.

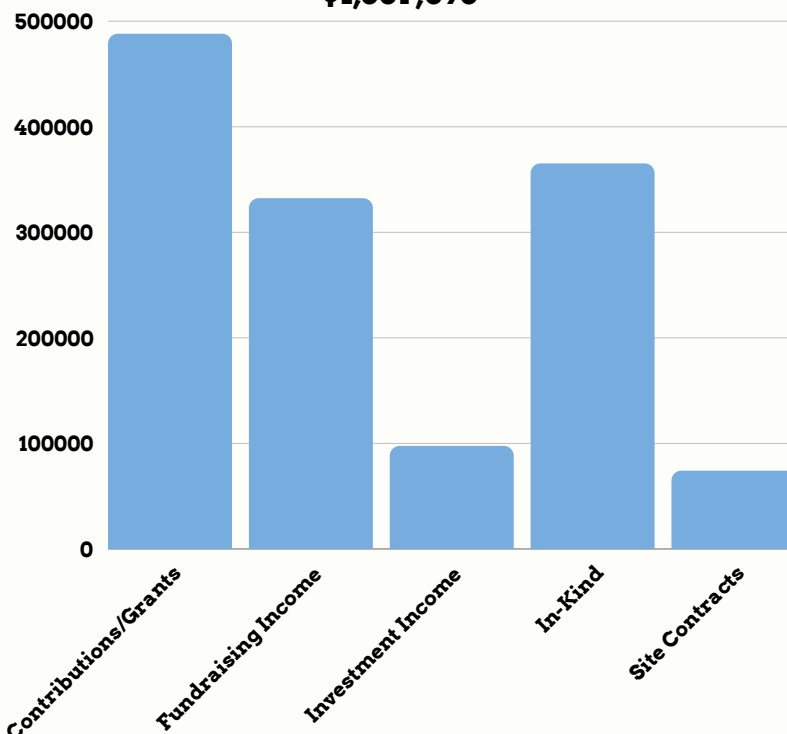

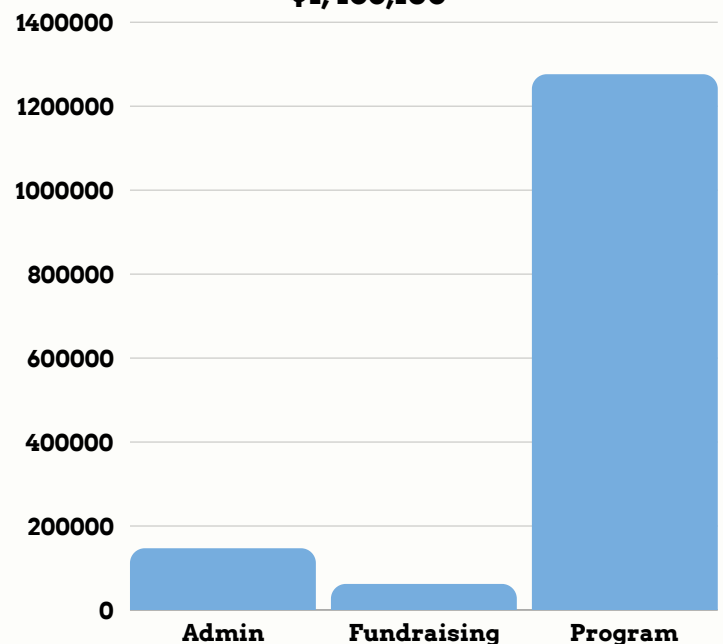

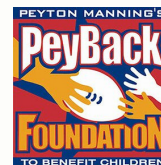
